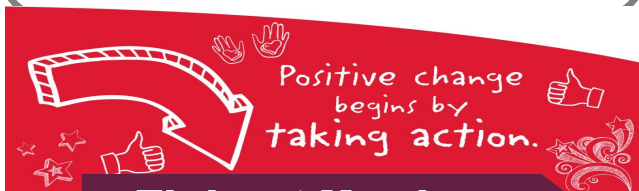

**You Matter Tour**

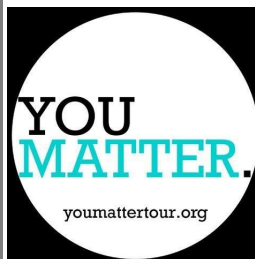
The **You Matter** National Tour is coming to **Faith Lutheran Church & Celebration Lutheran School!**
