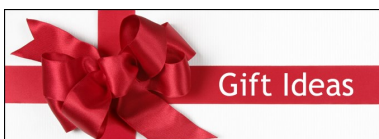


**Thrivent Members**

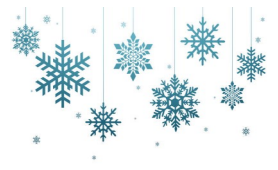


**Pre-Service Music**
