What CLS is doing currently to keep students safe?

Some of our everyday precautions are still in place:

- We will continue to communicate with email. Please read all emails from CLS.
- · Parents should still be doing daily health screenings (fever, cough, shortness of breath, etc)
- Lots of hand washing/sanitizing
- Face coverings (although there are a few with exemptions)
- Physical distancing
- Sanitizing high touch areas

New precautions due to Level Red:

- Visitors only if an emergency
- · Chapel done within classrooms or outside when weather permits
- Cross socialization of classes suspended

What we need from families:

- If you travel, be prepared to self-isolate per our Operational Response Plan
- Your child needs to be fever free for 24 hours without the use of medication to return to class
- If anyone in the household has a fever of 100.4 or higher, keep your children home
- No admittance if you have had contact with a person testing positive within the past 14 days
- Notify school office if someone in your household was exposed. Please be ready to give an explanation of the situation

If there is a confirmed case within our school:

- We will work directly with the health department, but it is possible that we will not have to quarantine the entire school.
- If a household family member tests positive, we will defer to the health dept on how to handle it
- We will abide by any mandates given by county or state health departments.
 We must follow rules of confidentiality, HIPAA, ADA and FERPA. Specifically, we can only give very generalized information.
