COVID Update

We have been monitoring news regarding the COVID crisis in our area and are aware that various cities/towns and county health departments have declared Public Health Emergencies due to the spike in COVID-19 cases. Wisconsin, and more specifically, northeast Wisconsin, is one of the country's top hot spots

for COVID outbreaks right now.



We are committed to continuing in-person instruction as long as we feel it is safe to do so. Right now, we are not planning on closing or suspending in-person classes although, as always, the COVID situation is

fluid and things may change. We feel that we are taking necessary precautions to keep students and staff safe during in-person classes.
