We are still trying hard to get everything working for our new hot lunch program.

- * We are giving feedback to Konop Foods each day so they can get to know our needs better.
- * If children decline a food, we ask them to take one piece to just try it.
- Most of their food must be gone before asking for seconds.
- * We have never run out of food. They send along extra, especially of the fruits and vegetables.
- * It helps tremendously if you turn in your order for the entire month at one time.

We are navigating how to handle it when a child is signed up for lunch, but they don't eat.

- * We will allow one sick day each month to not be charged to your account. If you think that your child will be out for a few days and they have lunch ordered for those days, let us know.
- If your child has ordered lunch, but forgets and brings in a cold lunch, we will ask them to eat their hot lunch.

Please chat with Miss Laura if you have any questions or concerns. We are addressing issues as they arise, so continue to watch for updates.

Drop Off/Pick Up

DROP OFF: 5K-8th Grade parents of continuing families are asked to drop off students to awaiting staff at the end of the middle sidewalk and/or the west side sidewalk. We will not be using the circle drive as we need to keep children safe walking into school as well as ensure it remains clear for a fire lane.

For the first few weeks, 4K Parents, new families or those that need to provide their child

emotional support will drop off their students outside their classrooms.

PICK-UP: The end of the day dismissal pattern will be similar to the drop off. 4K parents will

pick up their students outside the classroom while 5K – 8th Grades will be walked outside to meet parents/guardians.
