Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment will be early this year!!

For a variety of reasons, we will be doing re-enrollment for current families during December for the 2022-2023 school year. The fee of \$100 per student will not be charged until February 1, 2022. Responding by December 31, 2021 will guarantee your child's spot for next year. Beginning January 1, 2022 we will start to accept applications for potential new students. If you need to find out information about financial assistance please speak with Mrs. Ambroso. For questions on the School Choice voucher program, please speak with Mrs. Pickering.

Winter is upon us & with that comes school closures. CLS will close when severe weather strikes! In most cases, CLS will be closed if the Appleton Public Schools close for bad weather. However, we may be closed on days when the Appleton Public Schools chose to be open.
