

Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment will be early this year!!

For a variety of reasons, we will be doing re-enrollment for current families during December for the 2022-2023 school year. The fee of \$100 per student will not be charged until February 1, 2022. Responding by December 31, 2021 will guarantee your child's spot for next year. Beginning January 1, 2022 we will start to accept applications for potential new students.
