## Early Arrival Time

### ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Over the last month we have had more and more students being dropped off earlier than 8 am. Doors to classrooms do not officially open until 8:05. This leaves 10-30 min where children are being left unattended. According to our parent/student handbook, if a child arrives more than 10 minutes prior to class start time, they must proceed to Before School Care and be signed in by a parent no matter the age of the student. All staff are in devotions until 8 a.m., other than the person overseeing Before Care so there is no supervision outside of the gym. This policy applies to both before school and after school past 3:45pm. Even if your students are not signed into Before/After Care, parents will still be charged at the rate of \$6/hr per student. For the safety of the students, adult supervision is always required.

#### 4K Preschool Butterflies, Butterflies

The children in 4K Preschool used butterflies as the theme for this piece of art. To begin our butterfly projects, we read Eric Carle's *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* for inspiration.

To make our butterflies, we painted aluminum foil with markers and sprayed it with water to color our paper. We also used pearlescent watercolor paint and then markers to decorate our butterflies and all the students helped paint the background.

Finally, a quote by K. D'Angelo was added:  
"Butterflies are God's confetti,  
thrown upon the Earth  
in celebration of His love."



#### 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> grades LOVE

The students in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grades used glass to create this mosaic fused glass piece of art with the word LOVE as the theme.

Each student was given one section to design and make. The students were put into groups of two to create each letter and then they could design their own background. The top and bottom sections are filled with a design created by the assigned students. Then, the pieces were fired to fuse the glass.

The Bible verse was added to remind us all of God's immense LOVE for each of us.

#### Kindergarten & 1<sup>st</sup> grade Flowers

Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade used Georgia O'Keeffe's large flower paintings as inspiration for this flower painting. We began this project with students learning about the life and artwork of O'Keeffe.

The students practiced drawing large flowers and two of the students' flower drawings were selected to create the image for the classroom piece. Then, the large image was gridded and divided into one piece for each student. Pearlescent watercolors and markers were used to color each piece and then the pieces were put back together to create this large flower piece.

Finally, the Bible verse was added reminding us of God's creation.

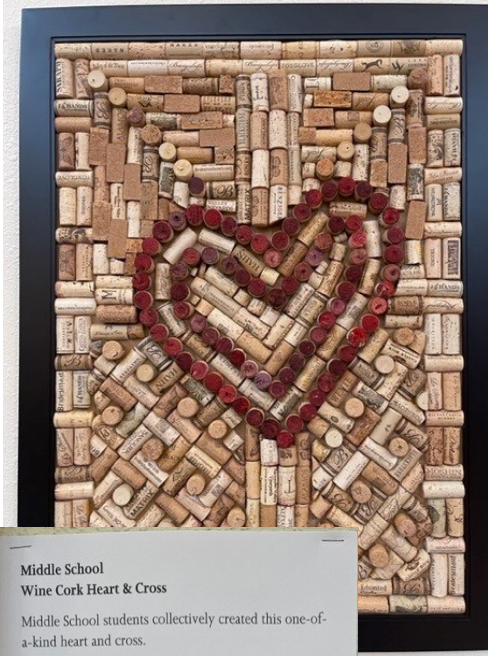

### Middle School Kiln-carved Glass "Quilt"

Middle School created a glass quilt for this art project. Using a new fused glass technique called kiln-carving, students created small Christian symbols with fiber paper. The shapes were designed, cut from fiber paper, glass was laid on top and then fired. Once fired, the fiber paper was removed to reveal the kiln-carved image. Finally, the pieces were put together to create a "quilt-like" image reminding us of the lyrics:

"We are one in the Spirit,  
We are one in the Lord."



### Middle School Wine Cork Heart & Cross

Middle School students collectively created this one-of-a-kind heart and cross.

Using unconventional materials—wine corks—students were divided into groups to create our image using a variety of repeated designs and patterns. Dyed corks were also used to create contrast and interest in the design.

This piece reminds us of God's love and sacrifice for each of us.



### 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades Fused Glass Cross

The students in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade class used glass to create this one-of-a-kind cross. Each student used a variety of glass shapes and colors to design and create a cross or heart. The glass squares were fired together to create this cross reminding us of God's love and sacrifice for each of us.

### ALL School Glass Tile Cross

This year, ALL of the students at CLS created this unique piece using glass. Students in each class created small glass tiles—some classes had a different theme and some designed their own.

4K—butterflies  
K-1<sup>st</sup>—flowers  
2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>—hearts  
4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>—design your own

The tiles were then assembled to resemble a cross and fused. While each tile is simple, when put together they create this symbol of love for Jesus and unity of the students at CLS.
