Early Arrival Time

Doors to classrooms do not officially open until 8:05. According to our parent/student handbook, if a child arrives more than 10 minutes prior to class start time, they must proceed to Before School Care and be signed in by a parent no matter the age of the student. Other than the person overseeing Before Care there is no supervision outside of the gym. This policy also applies after school past 3:45pm. Even if your students are not signed into Before/After Care, parents will still be charged the BASC rate. For the safety of the students, adult supervision is always required.

School Store

We have school store day coming up this Friday, Sept. 23rd. Your student has the opportunity to earn points every day in class to spend at the school store. For example, in 4th and 5th grade, each student starts with 5 points every day. They can lose points or gain points depending on their attitude and actions. Each classroom handles points in their own way, but every student has at least some points to spend at the store. Store items include small stuffed animals, Hot Wheels, balls, puzzles, pens/pencils, fidget toys, candy - anything you can think of that students from 4K to 8th grade would enjoy.
