To stay informed, you can check on Facebook (<https://www.facebook.com/CelebrationLutheranSchool/>), or watch the news on Channel 2 (WBAY), Channel 5 (WFRV), Channel 11 (WLUK) & Channel 26 (NBC 26) TV for announcements. School closing announcements occur typically between 6:30 and 8:00am and throughout the day when worsening conditions are expected.

Note: on days when school is closed due to weather, before and after school care is not available. If school is delayed due to bad weather, there is no before school care.

Qualifying for School Choice

CLS has been a part of the [Wisconsin Parental Choice Program](#) since 2018. Under this program – funded by the State of Wisconsin – parents have a voice in how their tax dollars are spent on the education of their children. If your family qualifies based on your income your child(ren) could receive a voucher to attend a private school of your choice for free. The income qualifications and details of the program are listed on our [website](#) but a family of four can earn as much as \$66,300 AGI (*Adjusted gross income*) and still qualify. Once your child qualifies they can remain in the program throughout high school. There are limited times at which your student can enter the program; if they are entering grade 4K, 5K or 1st Grade, they are transferring from a public school, or they are starting high school in 9th grade.



There is only one time during the year that the state accepts applications for enrollment. The Application period is Feb 1st through April 21st so in a couple weeks you can enroll for the 2023-2024 school year. Once you have submitted your application, please drop off your proof of residency to Mrs. Pickering. She will then provide verification and you should be set. CLS encourages all families to apply given the guidelines are based on Adjusted Gross Income. There is no cost to apply!

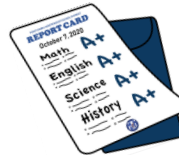
