

Starting Tuesday, Jan. 16th we will be making changes to our Drop off and Pick up portions of the day. These changes are a long time coming and we are so excited to now be able to utilize our parking lot space to a higher capacity to ensure ultimate student safety for all. I've attached a graphic of our lot showing the two different flow patterns we are going to start utilizing Tuesday, January 16th.

The BLUE arrows show the pattern flow for those opting to "drive thru" when dropping off or picking up their students. These vehicles will enter and exit using the Providence street entrance.

- Drop Off: Cars can drive under the overhang to drop off students beginning at 8:00am. Please make sure students do not exit your vehicle until a staff member is at the doors to allow them in.
- Pick up: Students will dismiss at 3:30pm to vehicles parked under the overhang. We ask that you do not exit your
 vehicle to ensure safety and keep the flow of traffic moving.

The RED arrows show the pattern flow for those opting to "walk in" when dropping off or picking up their students. These vehicles will enter and exit using the Evergreen drive entrance.

- Drop-off: Upon entering the parking lot, use the first lane and follow the marked arrows around to front parking stalls in the West lot(Indicated on graphic with small red arrows). After exiting the vehicle, please utilize the sidewalk (Red dotted path on graphic) to stay clear of actively moving traffic.
- Pick-up: Upon entering the parking lot, use the first lane and follow the marked arrows around to the front parking stalls in the West lot. You may then proceed into the school to collect your student in the vestibule area where
 all classes are gathered at 3:30pm.

Special Notes:

Bus riders: The bus will park at the first crosswalk (in between the two sidewalks). These are the only students
who will be allowed to walk out without an adult but will be monitored by the dismissal staff members.
