Computer Summer Camp

We will be sponsoring 2 week-long computer camps this summer for students currently enrolled in 5th through 8th grade. The camp is a one week experience for your middle school student to learn the basics of using Microsoft products, including Windows, PowerPoint, Excel, and Word. During the first day of class, a knowledge inventory will be assessed on each student to determine their strengths in each of these areas. The difficulty of the course material can be adjusted depending on student competency.
